This program helps Bear and Webelos Cubs (beginning of the 3rd grade through age 11) explore a wide range of activities in order to discover the presence of God in their daily lives as members of their family and parish. It also develops a good self-image by enabling the Cub to make contributions to the group or community. There is an Activity workbook to be used in conjunction with this program. It is available from the Scout Shops in our Council.

- Discuss your intentions to work on this emblem with your parents. You must have completed the second grade before beginning the Parvuli Dei Emblem Activity Book.
- Obtain the Parvuli Dei Activity Book from the Scout Shop or online at: <u>https://www.nccs-bsa.org/store/product/parvuli-dei-activity-book/</u>
- The book is designed for the Cub and their parent or guardian to work on together.
- Diocesan and BSA Youth Protection policies must be followed.
- The Cub will be required to make a banner as part of the requirements.
- When complete have your Cub Master sign the application form on the last page of your Activity Book, certifying that you have been a Registered Cub for at least 3 months.
- Meet with your parish priest (or designee), show them your completed Activity Book, and have him sign the application form, indicating that you have completed the requirements.

- The Catholic Committee on Scouting will present the Parvuli Dei emblems at its annual Awards Presentation at the Cathedral of the Assumption, next scheduled for January 28, 2024.
